- To fully enjoy the Port Arthur Region, you should allow at least two nights so that you have time to explore the Historic Site at leisure, experience an exciting ghost tour, and spend time taking in the other attractions and activities or just enjoying one of Tasman National Park's stunning walks.
- Once you reach Eaglehawk Neck, the Convict Trail will take you to seven fascinating historic locations that tell you the stories of the 19th century convict life.
- Whether you have one week or two days in the Port Arthur Region, you can make the most of your stay by using our travel planner to organise your time efficiently. - The Port Arthur Historic Site truly is Australia's premier historic site. The visitor centre is a world class complex. The Interpretation Gallery brings the convict era to life. Play the Lottery of Life and identify with the life of an actual convict. A great interactive experience for all ages. The visitor centre houses a large gift shop, café and at night a first class Restaurant.
